

UK Broadband Speed Test Results April 2015

This press release gives the aggregated speed test results from tests carried out by site users at www.broadband.co.uk for April 2015.

Virgin Media retain first place, with average download speeds increasing dramatically by 7.02Mb compared to last month. BT are in second place, with download speeds also increasing by 2.15Mb to 22.01Mb. Plusnet hold third place, with speeds rising by 3.59Mb to 18.18Mb. The rankings shuffle around after this, with Sky moving up to fourth place, download speeds improving by 0.90Mb taking them to 13.70Mb. EE's download speeds have also improved by 1.76Mb to 13.02Mb, putting them in fifth place. This knocks TalkTalk out of the top 5, with a drop of 1.81Mb in download speeds, taking them to 12.44Mb.

Overall, the average download speed across all providers has increased by 1.91Mb since last month.

Please note, EE are now owned by BT but will remain on the list until such time as current EE customers are transferred to the BT network.

Three Mobile have been added to the list as a comparison but are not included in the overall average speeds as these are limited to fixed line broadband suppliers only.

Our average speed by time of day shows how the average broadband speed is heavily influenced by the time of day (and therefore likely level of network congestion).

For providers such as Virgin Media and Plusnet, the overnight level shows significantly higher average speeds than the evening peak periods. This clearly shows the effects of network congestion on the average broadband connection at peak hours.

Three have been removed from this list due to having too few overnight numbers to make the results statistically significant.

- Our results are taken from our website users performing speed tests using our speed checker at http://www.broadband.co.uk/broadband-speed-test/
