

UK Broadband Speed Test Results March 2012

This press release gives the aggregated speed test results from tests carried out by site users at www.broadband.co.uk for March 2012.

Virgin Media retains first place, with average download speeds this month increasing by almost 2Mbps over last month. Eclipse remains in second place despite falling in average speed. BT are still in third place, with nearly 1Mbps increase in download speeds over February.

Overall the average download and upload speeds for all providers has increased since February.

Our average speed by time of day shows how the average broadband speed is heavily influenced by the time of day (and therefore likely level of network congestion).

The overnight level shows significantly higher average speeds than the evening peak period. This clearly shows the effects of network congestion on the average broadband connection at peak hours.

- Our results are taken from our website users performing speed tests using our speed checker at http://www.broadband.co.uk/broadband-speed-test/
- We record tens of thousands of speed tests every month.
- Unlike other speed test services we record the Internet Service Provider (ISP) by IP address making our ISP recording very accurate rather than relying on self selection
- We pick out the following ISP's for reporting every month

 - BE Broadband and O2 (O2 and BE are separate trading entities; however they share a common infrastructure)

 - Tiscali and Talk Talk combined (as TalkTalk purchased Tiscali and began merging the brands in January 2010).
