

UK Broadband Speedtest Results November 2008

This press release gives the aggregated speedtest results from tests carried out by site users at www.broadband.co.uk for November 2008.

During November 2008 Virgin Media have improved their average speed by over 0.5Mbps confirming them as the UK's fastest broadband supplier.

The average over all tests was a download speed of 3.216Mbps, which is now the fourth monthly drop in a row since July 2008's average of 3.609Mbps.

Our average speed by time of day shows how the average broadband speed is heavily influenced by the time of day (and therefore likely level of network congestion).

The overnight levels show a significantly higher average speed than the evening peak period, with daytime use between the two. This clearly shows the effects of network congestion on the average broadband connection at peak hours.

Virgin Media for the third month running take the number 1 slot in all three time periods with increased average speeds.

- Our results are taken from our website users performing speedtests using our speedchecker at http://www.broadband.co.uk/broadband-speed-test.jsp
- We record tens of thousands of speedtests every month.
