

UK Broadband Speed Test Results April 2012

Virgin Media retains first place, with average download speeds this month increasing by almost 5Mbps over last month. BT take second place with almost a 4Mbps increase in average speed. Eclipse drop to third place, but have a 1Mb increase in average speed over last month.

Overall the average download and upload speeds for all providers has increased since March.

Our average speed by time of day shows how the average broadband speed is heavily influenced by the time of day (and therefore likely level of network congestion).

The overnight level shows significantly higher average speeds than the evening peak period. This clearly shows the effects of network congestion on the average broadband connection at peak hours.

- Our results are taken from our website users performing speed tests using our speed checker at http://www.broadband.co.uk/broadband-speed-test/
- We record tens of thousands of speed tests every month.
