

# **UK Broadband Speedtest Results July 2008**

This press release gives the aggregated speedtest results from tests carried out by site users at <a href="https://www.broadband.co.uk">www.broadband.co.uk</a> for July 2008.

O2 and Be's lead over Virgin media has narrowed to only just over half a megabit per second form nearly 1.5 megabits per second in June.

Eclipse Broadband again trail in last place with an average download speed of only 1.768Mbps.

The average over all tests was a download speed of 3.609Mbps, which is a good increase of nearly 10% on June 2008's average of 3.330Mbps.

Our average speed by time of day shows how the average broadband speed is heavily influenced by the time of day (and therefore likely level of network congestion).

The overnight levels show a significantly higher average speed than the evening peak period, with daytime use between the two. This clearly shows the effects of network congestion on the average broadband connection at peak hours.

The winner this month is again O2 and Be although their lead is being eaten into by Virgin Media who actually manage to beat O2 and Be in the overnight slot.

The average speeds throughout the day also shows an improvement on June 2008's figures.
