

UK Broadband Speed Test Results May 2015

This press release gives the aggregated speed test results from tests carried out by site users at <u>www.broadband.co.uk</u> for May 2015.

Virgin Media retain first place, with average download speeds dropping by 1.94Mb to 44.82Mb since last month. BT are in second place, with download speeds also decreasing by 0.88Mb to 21.13Mb. Plusnet hold third place, with speeds also dropping by 1.50Mb to 16.69Mb. Sky remain in fourth place, download speeds holding stable at 13.70Mb. TalkTalk move back up to fifth place, with a 0.44Mb increase in download speeds, taking them to 12.89Mb.

Overall, the average download speed across all providers has decreased by 0.63Mb since last month.

Please note, EE are now owned by BT but will remain on the list until such time as current EE customers are transferred to the BT network.

Three Mobile have been added to the list as a comparison but are not included in the overall average speeds as these are limited to fixed line broadband suppliers only.

Our average speed by time of day shows how the average broadband speed is heavily influenced by the time of day (and therefore likely level of network congestion).

For providers such as Virgin Media and Plusnet, the overnight level shows significantly higher average speeds than the evening peak periods. This clearly shows the effects of network congestion on the average broadband connection at peak hours.

Three have been removed from this list due to having too few overnight numbers to make the results statistically significant.

- Our results are taken from our website users performing speed tests using our speed checker at <u>http://www.broadband.co.uk/broadband-speed-test/</u>
- We record tens of thousands of speed tests every month.
