

UK Broadband Speed Test Results October 2011

This press release gives the aggregated speed test results from tests carried out by site users at www.broadband.co.uk for October 2011.

Average download & upload speeds – October 2011

** Note that although O2 and BE share a common infrastructure they are separate trading entities*

Virgin Media again retains first place, seeing a small increase in average download and upload speed. Eclipse jumps into second place with a big gain in both download and upload speeds. BT falls back to third place with a significant drop in average speeds. O2/BE retain the fourth place position.

Overall the average download and upload speeds for all providers have dropped in comparison to September, despite Virgin Media and Eclipse's gains.

Our average speed by time of day shows how the average broadband speed is heavily influenced by the time of day (and therefore likely level of network congestion).

The overnight level shows significantly higher average speeds than the daytime and evening peak periods. This clearly shows the effects of network congestion on the average broadband connection at peak hours.
