

## **UK Broadband Speed Test Results September 2011**

This press release gives the aggregated speed test results from tests carried out by site users at <a href="https://www.broadband.co.uk">www.broadband.co.uk</a> for September 2011.

Virgin Media again retains first place, despite average download speeds dropping for a second month. BT wins back second place from Eclipse who nonetheless continue to show gains in download speed. O2/BE retain the fourth place position.

Overall the average download speeds for all providers have dropped very slightly, while upload speeds have seen a similarly small increase.

Our average speed by time of day shows how the average broadband speed is heavily influenced by the time of day (and therefore likely level of network congestion).

The overnight level shows significantly higher average speeds than the evening peak period. This clearly shows the effects of network congestion on the average broadband connection at peak hours.

- Our results are taken from our website users performing speed tests using our speed checker at <a href="http://www.broadband.co.uk/broadband-speed-test/">http://www.broadband.co.uk/broadband-speed-test/</a>
- We record tens of thousands of speed tests every month.
- Unlike other speed test services we record the Internet Service Provider (ISP) by IP address making our ISP recording very accurate rather than relying on self selection
